GUIDELINES AND FEES

ELIGIBILITY: All residents of California

FEES: \$35 for up to 3 entries. Check payable to Santa Barbara County Park Foundation. All fees are non-refundable.

MEDIUM: All two-dimensional images of any County Park, (*see attachment for list of County Parks, open spaces and Preserves), including paintings, drawings, prints, mixed media and photographs. All artworks must be the exhibiting artist's original work. Selected works must be ready to hang with wire hangers on the back of each piece, completed within the past 3 years.

SIZE LIMIT: No wider than 48"

SALES: Checks will be written directly to the artists. Artists are encouraged to contribute a tax deductible donation of 25% of all sales to the Santa Barbara County Arts Commission.

PRIZES: Cash awards totaling \$500.00 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place and one Honorable Mention prize.

SELECTED WORKS ONLY DELIVERY: On Saturday, September 25, from 9:30 – 11:30am, at the Channing Peake Gallery, located on the 1st floor of the County Administration Building, 105 E. Anapamu St., Santa Barbara. Park in the County Admin. Bldg. rear lot and enter through the rear doors only. Enter County parking lot on Santa Barbara St. or Victoria St. No works may be shipped.

REGISTRATION: Register by U.S. mail by filling out this downloadable form; include a check for the entry fee payable to **Santa Barbara Park Foundation**. To mail your entry, print and cut out the form below and fill in the requested information (please print legibly)

CHECKLIST FOR ALL ENTRIES:

- Submit a PC compatible disk with high resolution 300 dpi jpg images, 5 x7" for up to three works; label each digital file with last name and abbreviated title of you work (ex. Smith.TuckersGrove.jpg) Write your name on the CD with permanent marker.
- Submit a 100 word or less statement about your work, written in the first person, WORD format, Arial Font, size 10.
- Submit a separate bio or resume.

NO CDS WILL BE RETURNED; ALL CDS WILL BE DESTROYED
